APPLICATION

Organizations interested in participating in the ACCESS4ALL COMMUNITIES program, should fill out the attached form. Please submit only one application per organization. Your organization will be contacted as soon as specific performances have been identified for an upcoming show.

- Tickets are allotted based on availability; submission of an application form does not guarantee tickets to an upcoming performance.
- The 5th Avenue Theatre is committed to making every 5th Avenue-produced show available to as many program participants as possible; however, tickets to *touring* shows, co-productions, and other shows *not* produced by our theater will not be available for us to offer through this program.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. **RECIPIENTS:** Ticket recipients should be families, individuals, and volunteers associated with your organization. Recipients should be individuals who would otherwise be unable to afford admission to a 5th Avenue production. (Exceptions may be made for chaperones of minors or other necessary staff.)
2. **VALUE OF TICKETS:** As donated tickets have monetary value, the partnering organization will make every possible effort to ensure that each donated ticket is used. Unused tickets may lead to forfeiture of program privileges.
3. **YOUNG CHILDREN:** Each recipient should be no younger than age 4, in compliance with 5th Avenue policy. No “babes in arms” will be permitted.
4. **ADA ACCOMODATIONS:** Organizations requiring special accommodations or ADA access will communicate specific needs to Community Engagement Specialist in advance so that Front of House staff may be properly advised.

DISTRIBUTION OF TICKETS

INVITED DRESS REHEARSALS

If your organization is invited to a special community preview, no physical tickets will be issued. Your group members should simply check in with a staff member as they arrive and follow usher’s instructions regarding seating.

TICKETED PREVIEWS

If your organization is invited to an evening performance, ticket vouchers will be sent to your organization to be distributed to your members.



GENERAL PERFORMANCE INFORMATION

THEATRE LOCATION

The 5th Avenue Theatre is on 5th Avenue just north of the intersection of 5th Avenue and University Street in downtown Seattle. The theater address is 1308 5th Avenue, Seattle, WA 98101.

THEATRE DOORS OPEN

Lobby doors open 45 minutes before the show and seating begins 30 minutes before the curtain. Performances begin promptly. Patrons who arrive late will be seated at the first suitable pause in the performance in the least disruptive location.

BRINGING CHILDREN

Children under four years of age, *including babes in arms*, will not be admitted. 5th Avenue productions are generally suitable for ages 8 and above. Seat cushions for little ones are available at no charge at our Coat Check. Some shows deal with mature themes and may not be appropriate for all children. WHAT TO WEAR

Attire generally varies from patron to patron. For some, attending a show at The 5th is a special occasion and an opportunity to dress up. Others prefer casual attire. Above all, we want you to feel comfortable.

LOBBY AMENITIES, FOOD & DRINK

Refreshments are available for purchase both pre-show and during intermission. Drinks may be pre-ordered for intermission. Show-specific merchandise is available at the lobby merchandise booth.

SEAT CUSHIONS & SPECIAL NEEDS

Our complimentary Coat Check has seat cushions for smaller and shorter patrons, as well as Braille show programs and assisted listening devices. Binoculars may be rented for \$5.00.

CAMERAS, CELL PHONES, & ELECTRONIC DEVICES

The use of cameras and audio recording equipment *is strictly prohibited*. You may leave these items at our Coat Check. Please turn off all cell phones, pagers and watch alarms before the performance begins. Texting during performances is also strictly prohibited.
